Phonics

This week the sounds we have revised are:

Maths

This week in Maths we have been exploring:

numbers beyond 10 (11-20)



We have been learning to recognise numbers beyond 10 - the teen numbers!

We have been thinking about the teen numbers as 'one ten and extra ones'. E.g. 17 is made of one ten and seven ones.

This week we have thought about where
Australia is in the world and how it is made of
states and territories. We have thought about
some of the weather they experience in
Australia and how this can differ from the
North and South

We have looked at the directions on a compass to help us with describing positions.

Medicines

This week, we have started our new PSHE them of medicines and drugs.

We have explored how things enter our bodies e.g. through our mouths, noses, ears, skin and eyes.



We have started to look at how there are medicines called drugs that we can take to help us feel better. But there are some drugs that are not medicines.
