
Trinity Prayer Space 18/5/21

We had 3 prayer spaces in one using the inside and outside of a gazebo and a little tent to explore the 3 parts of the Trinity — God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit.





For God the Father, the children laid on the floor and thought about what God the Father looked like, what he is like and what big question they would like to ask him. Our Foundation Governors tried to answer some of these questions at the end of the day via Teams. Will you come to earth again? (KS1) Will you come and play with me? (KS1) Why are people mean and why don't you stop people destroying the earth? (Y3&4) Why don't you stop Covid 19? (Y3&4) Who made God? (Y5&6) Are people in heaven happy? (Y5&6)



God the Son allowed children to discuss the stories they know about Jesus and what Christians might learn from them about how to live their life. We discussed what sins are and that Jesus died so that our sins were forgiven. Each child had the chance to draw or write about a sin they had done in the sand, and then wipe the slate clean by saying sorry and asking for forgiveness.





For God the Holy Spirit, the children heard the story of Ascension and Pentecost again, where Jesus told his disciples he would send a special helper and that he would always be with them (our school Christian vision). We talked about the 'fruits of the spirit' — gentleness, self-control, loving, kindness, joy, peace, goodness, patience, faithfulness. The children reflected on which 'fruit of the spirit' they already had lots of and recorded this on a fruit. On the back they asked the Holy Spirit to help them with the one they felt they needed more of. These were hung on the tree.



At the end of the day, we joined together for each class to share what they had learnt about the Trinity and for Don and Jane to try to answer some of our big questions. This is what Y5&6 learnt:
