


## Woodpeckers Class -Autumn 1

During this topic, we will be focussing on our social and emotional learning. Also we'll find out about how we fit into the world around us and how we can be responsible citizens in our community.

In **PSHE**, we will be finding out about how to belong to our class and follow the rules. We will also explore where we belong in our community and who is there to support us.

As **scientists**, we will learn about different habitats and how these can change over time, also how we classify animals.

We will be authors and we will be exploring a wide range of text types, linking to Oliver Jeffers' book, 'Here We Are'.

In **RE**, we will be learning about what 'mission' means to Christians and how we this can be applied to us as responsible citizens.

As artists, we will use different collage techniques, whilst learning how to mix and create various tones and colours using paint. Our original artwork will be influenced by the illustrations in the book 'The Colour Monster'.


Key Vocabulary	
community	A group of people living in the same place or having a particular characteristic in common.
emotion	How we feel.
belonging	Being part of a group and how we fit in.
relationship	Ways in which people or things are connected.
role	Part played by a person in society.
environment	The surroundings in which a person, animal or plant lives.
well-being	The state of being comfortable, healthy, or happy.
texture	The way an object feels to the touch or looks as it may feel if it were touched.
primary colours	The colours red, yellow, or blue, that when mixed creates other colours.
secondary colours	A colour formed by mixing two primary colours.
mission	One who is sent on a mission, especially one sent to do religious or charitable work.
Pentecost	A major festival in the Christian church, also known as 'Whitsunday'.
