

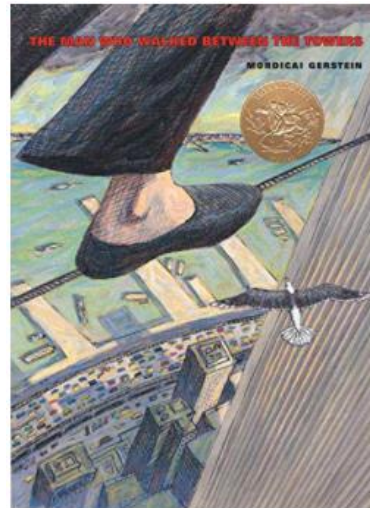
In Science, we will be investigating forces

As scientists we will explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object. We will identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction, that act between moving surfaces. Finally, we will identify that some mechanisms, including levers, pulleys and gears, allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.

In English, we will be writing newspaper reports

As authors we will look at the book 'The Man Who Walked Between the Towers' which is about a French aerialist called Philippe Petit who, in 1974, threw a tightrope between the two towers of the World Trade Center. He then spent an hour walking, dancing and performing high-wire tricks a quarter of a mile in the sky. We will be writing newspaper reports about this extraordinary event.

Supply chain	A process that involves a supplier of materials to be made into products that are then sold in shops.
Trade route	A route that is taken by ships who are exporting or importing products.
Migration	The process of going from one country, region or place to another.
Resistance	Resistance forces, such as water, air, friction and gravity, are those that oppose another force.
Streamlined	An object that is designed to have the least possible resistance to a force such as air and water.
Pulley	A wheel driven by or driving a belt used to deliver force to a machine or another belt at a certain speed.
Gravity	The force of attraction by which things fall towards the centre of the earth.
