During PSHE we will be focusing on Sex and Relationships Education

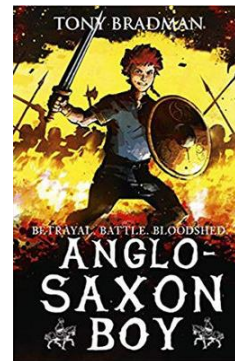
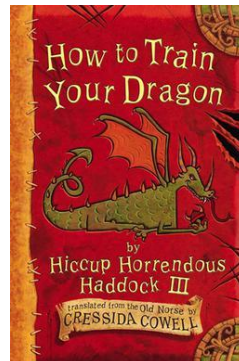
