
















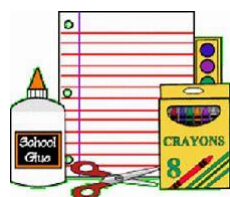

We will learn a lot about hygiene and how important it is to be clean and exercise, including how we can use exercise to help us calm down and how to keep our teeth clean.

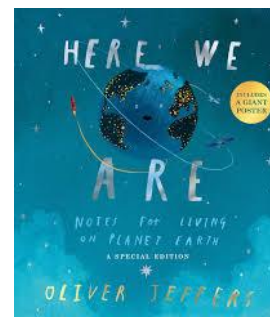
We will be exploring the different animals in our world, how they are the same and different. Do they all live in the same places? Do they move in the same way?



We will be exploring different art materials and resources to learn how to colour mix and draw our own self-portraits. We will learn how to use scissors correctly and safely.



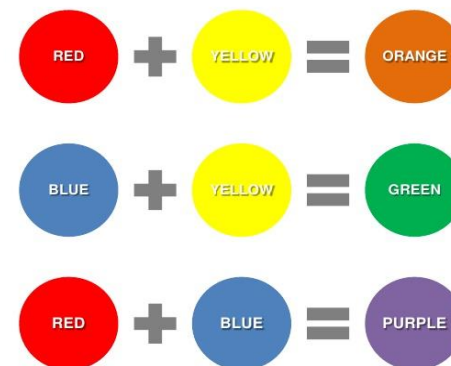
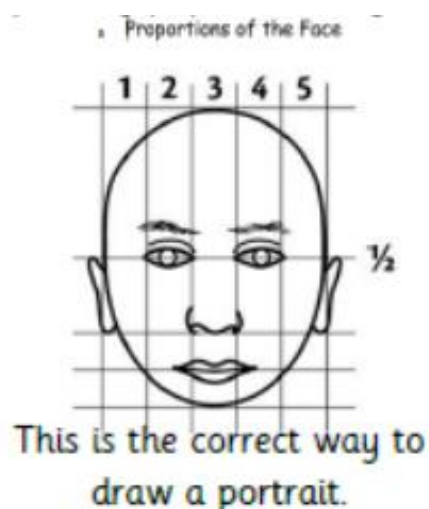
We will learn about why belonging to God and the church family is important to Christians and how Baptism helps them to belong.

Key Vocabulary	
<b>habitat</b>	A <b>habitat</b> is the natural place something lives. A <b>habitat</b> provides <b>living</b> things with everything they need to <b>survive</b> such as food, shelter and water.
<b>microhabitat</b>	A <b>microhabitat</b> is a very small <b>habitat</b> in places like under a rock, under leaves or on a branch. Minibeasts live in <b>microhabitats</b> . The <b>microhabitats</b> have everything they need to <b>survive</b> .
<b>depend</b>	Many <b>living</b> things in a <b>habitat</b> <b>depend</b> on each other. This means they need each other for different things.
<b>survive</b>	This means to stay alive.
