We will be exploring different art materials and resources to learn how to colour mix and draw our own self-portraits. We will learn how to use scissors correctly and safely.




Here are some of the word you might hear grown-ups use during your learning.

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
We will learn about why belonging to God and the church family is important to Christians and how Baptism helps them to belong.




Our Literacy, will be based on the book 'Here we are – Notes for living on Planet Earth' by Oliver Jeffers.

Key Vocabulary	
habitat	A habitat is the natural place something lives. A habitat provides living things with everything they need to survive such as food, shelter and water.
microhabitat	A microhabitat is a very small habitat in places like under a rock, under leaves or on a branch. Minibeasts live in microhabitats. The microhabitats have everything they need to survive.
depend	Many living things in a habitat depend on each other. This means they need each other for different things.
survive	This means to stay alive.
