Notes for these lessons

• Use the word cards without sound buttons to check that the children can easily recognise the digraphs and trigraphs.

• Model reading the longer words using the chunking method. Ensure the children can read these longer words using this method. When this method is secure, model reading the longer words in one go.

• **The tricky words 'put', 'pull' and 'full' may not be tricky in some regional pronunciations and in which case should not be treated as such. Instead, add the words to Revisit and review: words.

• There are no new tricky words for Spring 2.
