2. How much money do I have in pounds if I have:
a) 340 US Dollars $340 \div 1.25=£ 272.00$
b) 400 Canadian Dollars $400 \div 4.59=£ 87.15$
c) 2000 Indian Rupee $2000 \div 95=£ 21.05$
d) 480 Chinese Yuan $480 \div 8.84=£ 54.30$
e) 600 Euros $600 \div 1.11=£ 540.54$
3. I am going on a trip to the USA so I need to convert my money into US Dollars. How many dollars will I have if I start with:
a) 600 Swiss Francs $600 \div 0.95=$ US\$631.58
b) 800 New Zealand Dollars $800 \div 1.55=$ US $\$ 516.13$
c) 900 Emirati Dirhams $900 \div 3.67=$ US $\$ 245.23$
d) 1000 Rupee $1000 \div 76.14=$ US $\$ 13.13$
e) 50 Canadian Dollars $50 \div 1.35=$ US $\$ 37.04$
4. Below are the prices of two items, they are the same but were bought in different countries, say which country sold the item for cheaper. Convert into pounds to compare.
a) China $=300$ Malaysia $=160 \quad 300 \div 8.84=£ 33.94160 \div 5.34=£ 29.96$
b) Australia=60 Canada=90 $60 \div 1.82=£ 32.9790 \div 4.59=£ 20.70$
c) India=1500 Emirates $=80 \quad 1500 \div 95=£ 15.7980 \div 6.16=£ 12.99$
d) USA $=70$ Switzerland $=6070 \div 1.25=£ 56.0060 \div 1.19=£ 50.42$
e) France $=200$ USA $=240200 \div 1.11=£ 180.18 \quad 240 \div 1.25=£ 192.00$
