- 5. After returning to the graveyard, what do you think the girl is going to do now?
- 6. Why do you think the girl visited the grave on the 'Day of the Dead' festival?
- 7. When the girl's plate is piled high, what are the skeletons planning on doing with her?
- 8. Who do you think sent the blue flower? Give reasons for your answer.



- 9. Explain how the director of the film shows a contrast between the town and the graveyard.
- 10. Explain how the director has injected humour into the film.
- 11. Explain how tension is created before the skeleton band appears (45 seconds into the film).
- 12. Explain why the skeletons have painted faces.



- 13. How do we know that the girl did not imagine it?
- 14. How was the girl pulled into the underworld?
- 15. Who is the skeleton in the blue skirt with the blue flower?
- 16. What does the girl use to smash the piñata?
