



Introduction	Today the children will look at words that end with 'er', or' and 'ar'.		
Main Teaching Activity	Get the children, in pairs, to think of any words that end with an /e sound and write them down. Can they think of any spelling rules that they could apply to spellings? Is there a pattern or anything that appears frequently with the different endings? Get the children to share their ideas and discuss any misconceptions.		
Independent Activity	Get children to write the word 'particular" across their mini white board. Set a 7 minute timer and see who can add as many of the spelling list words in to a scrabble web as possible.		
	You can use the example on the slide below if they need some support getting started.		
	Feedback and if time, draw a scrabble web on the board as a class.
