
In Writing we will be producing a narrative piece of writing based on 'The Building Boy' by Ross Montgomery and David Litchfield.



In Geography we will be focusing on continents, oceans, and countries and seas of the UK, where you will be able to revisit and apply what you already know. We will use world maps, atlases and globes. We will also be identifying seasonal and daily weather patterns in the UK and the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the equator and the North and South poles.



In Science we will be learning about the seasons and weather, thinking about how these change throughout the year. We will also be learning about trees, thinking about how they might change through the seasons. We will also have some exciting opportunities to be scientists and conduct experiments on leaves and trees.



In Art we will be developing our drawing skills and the techniques that can be used to create different effects. This will go towards creating our own drawings of animals using your own toolkit of mark making techniques.



In RE we will have a Christianity focus. We will be engaging with the concept of 'belonging' to a church family; enquiring into Baptism/Christening as a mark of belonging to God and the Church; exploring Jesus' own example of 'Welcome', the practise of baptism in the Church of England, and how belonging to the church family helps in Christian living. During this topic we will be aiming to visit our local Church in order to understand more about our focus.
