
In Writing, we will be focusing on the simple retelling of a narrative and non-chronological reports.




Y1/2 Curriculum map Summer 1



In History we will be learning about changes to shops within living memory. We will consider how we have grown and changed in our lives and then explore what shops in our community where like in the past and how they have changed.



In Science we will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. We will also find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.



In DT we will be designing and making handwarmers. We will be learning how to thread a needle, as well as exploring different types of threads and fabrics. We will practise a running stitch to join two pieces of fabric together.

In RE, we will be exploring how Pentecost reminds Christians that God is with them always.

In Computing we will be learning to use a digital device to take photographs, describe what makes a good photograph and explore tools to change an image.

KS1 How does celebrating Pentecost remind Christians that God is with them always?

Prior learning:

God is a VIP.
Jesus is God's son. He told parables to teach about God.
Everyone is welcome into the Christian family.
Christians pray to God and worship him in different ways.

What should we know?

Christians believe:

- When Jesus returned to heaven he promised to send a helper.
- The helper was the Holy Spirit who arrived at Pentecost.
- The Holy Spirit is like an invisible friend who reminds us God is with us always.
- Pentecost is a celebration of the birthday of the church.
- The Holy Spirit makes us more like Jesus.



What should we be able to do?

Retell parts of the Ascension and Pentecost story.
Describe the Holy Spirit as a helper or friend.
Describe some of the ways Pentecost celebrated in a church.



In PSHE we will be focusing on managing risk. We will develop our understanding of the importance of people we can turn to regularly for help, support and reassurance. We will also discuss times we may need to turn to an adult we do not know for help and discuss the safest ways to do this.

In Music, we will be focusing on the song rockpool rock and the style of music, rock 'n' roll. We will then work together to create a piece of music in this style.
