

Here is some of the vocabulary you might hear adults talk about.

straddle	To stay or move with the legs wide apart.
Pike	Sitting with long arms and legs straight.
tuck	A curled shape.
pitch	A high or low sound.
castle	A large, strong building where a noble lived with his family and servants.
catapult	An ancient weapon used to throw objects, such as large stones or arrows, at an enemy.
moat	A deep ditch dug around a castle, fort, or town for protection against enemies.
defend	To protect from harm
battlements	A wall along the top of a castle, fort, or tower that has openings for people to shoot through.
portcullis	A strong, sliding grill suspended at the top of a fortification gateway that can be lowered to prevent entry, as to a castle.
exercise	Activity done to keep the body or mind strong or to make them stronger.
healthy	Having to do with a good mind and body.

We will be exploring healthy choices, how to make healthy choices, why food and drink is good for us, why we need exercise and why we need sleep.





### Why do Christians put a cross in the Easter Garden?





### Music
