Here is some of the vocabulary you might hear adults talk about.

precious	Something that is very special to someone.
safari	An expedition for watching large animals.
savannah	A flat plain covered with grass that also has scattered trees.
murky	Dark or gloomy.
gulp	To take large swallows of drink.
plantain	A fruit similar to the banana, but larger, firmer, and less sweet.
perplexed	Puzzled, confused, or uncertain.
amphibious	Able to travel or operate on both land and water.
vehicle	Something used to carry and move people or things.
consent	To give permission or approval
lifeguard	A person hired to watch over a swimming area and rescue anyone who might be drowning.
fuel	Liquid put into a vehicle to make it work.

In PSHE we will be learning how to keep ourselves safe by recognizing how our bodies feel when we are in danger.


We will be exploring signs of spring!



