










Lowry's Cities: Factories






A factory is a building where people work making things.

Drawing Lowry Buildings



You will need...



- 1. Draw a tower on one side of the paper. Draw it right up to the top.
- 2. Next, draw a big factory building. This goes up to the top fold of your paper.
- 3. Next, fill the rest of the page with a row of terraced houses. Draw these to the bottom fold on your paper.
- 4. Use your marker pen to draw in the doors, windows and roofs on your buildings.
