Who is LS Lowry?

























He painted animals and people.







Lowry loved the sea and often went on holiday to the seaside.


He painted lots of seascape paintings.

How can you make these colours from red, blue, yellow, black and white?



- 4. If you want, you can add a lighthouse, a beach or a boat.






























