














Our Work So Far





How do we use scissors safely?




































You will need...



- 1. Very carefully cut out your buildings.
- 2. Stick the buildings on to your background- make sure you can see your hills behind them.
- 3. Cut out your matchstick figures. Take your time! If you make a mistake, use sticky tape to mend it.
- 4. Glue your matchstick figures in front of your buildings.
