design	The process of planning and creating something	
template	A pattern used as a guide for cutting or drawing round	
evaluate	Make a judgement on it	
running stitch	Needle goes in and out of the fabric	


What materials are things made of and why?

We will be finding things made of metal, plastic, wood, cardboard, fabric, paper and looking at some of the properties of these materials, like whether we can bend them, or if they are waterproof or see through.



What puppet will you design and make?

We will be looking at the puppets in our classroom and how they have been made. We will be designing our own sock puppet and using glue and running stitch to join things on to the sock like eyes and hair.

What electronic devices do I use at school and at home?


We will look at how to use the computers and tablets in school safely and what things we have at home that are controlled by a computer chip inside of them.
