deciduous	Having leaves that drop off each year
evergreen	Having green leaves that stay on a plant throughout the year.

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In Maths we will be exploring numbers to 10 and addition and subtraction. We will begin to understand odd and even numbers as well as spatial reasoning and capacity.

This half term we will continue our focus on writing captions, labels, simple sentences and challenging ourselves to write stories. We will be practicing our segmenting and blending skills to help with sounding out words.

We will be exploring different aspects of growing and changing. We will discuss how we have changed as well as our local area. We will also observe seasonal changes in our environment.








What makes every single person unique and precious?
