past	Having happened at an earlier time.
material	Anything used for building or making something else.
habitat	The natural environment of an animal or plant.
parable	a very short story told to teach a moral or religious lesson.
rescue	to free or save.
river	a large natural stream of water flowing in a particular course toward a lake, ocean, or other body of water.
doubling	having two equal parts
