

QUIET LANES IN

COPDOCK & WASHBROOK

Quiet Lanes form part of the highway infrastructure and are nationally recognised designations of single-track road where visitors and locals can enjoy the natural surroundings and use them for activities such as cycling, horse-riding, jogging and walking, whilst sharing them with road users.

Their purpose is to make these roads **safer** and more **enjoyable for everyone** to use.

The Parish Council's Quiet Lanes **Expression of Interest** has been approved for part of **Back Lane**, part of **Church Lane** and **Folly Lane** (see reverse for locations). The next phase of the application is to develop the detailed plans, discuss the proposals at a residents' awareness and consultation session (a public meeting), approve the final plans and submit the application before the deadline of **1st March 2022**.
