


A Celtic queen of the Iceni tribe. She joined with other tribes to fight against the Roman army.






In Geography will be investigating Colchester and comparing human and physical features with Ipswich. We will develop our map skills to explore how we will travel to Colchester.



We will be constructing castles and investigating pulleys and lever mechanisms which were used in parts of castles to defend themselves.

What is a lever?

A lever is a simple machine which helps us to lift objects. It has a long arm and a fulcrum, which is where the arm pivots. The object you are lifting is called the load, and the force you apply to the arm to make the object move is called the effort.

What is a pulley?

A pulley is a wheel on a fixed axle with a groove in it to guide a rope or cable. The rope or cable is attached to the object you want to lift and looped over the pulley so that the end of the rope is hanging down on the other side. The pulley changes the direction of the force needed to lift the object or the amount of force that is needed to lift an object.


Christians pray to God and worship him in different ways.
