

Colons

The colon looks like a full stop hovering over another full stop.

Using a colon:

- The most common use for the colon is to introduce a list.
You can only use a colon to introduce a list if the first part of the sentence makes sense on its own.
- A colon can also be used to separate main clauses, where the second main clause expands on the first and adds extra detail.

Complete the activities below to show your understanding of how to use colons.




A: Insert a colon into each list below so that it is punctuated correctly.

3. I can't wait to go to the theme park it has the best rides.

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
Colons

- after a character's name in a playscript before they say their line,
 - to introduce a definition,
 - or when writing the time.

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


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
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
