


As authors, we will be writing travel journals based on a safari. We will also be learning the features of a non-chronological report and writing our own about big cats.





In Science, we will be learning about habitats and life cycles. We will use our knowledge of animals and living things to help us when investigating where they live and where they come in different food chains. We will also learn why plants and animals need one another.





In PSHE we will be learning about personal safety, thinking about how to be safer in a variety or personal safety co texts.
