





Summer 1 2022 EYFS Curriculum map

As authors, we will be creating a small world Africa and going on a safari. We will write simple sentences about what we saw. Also, we will be writing simple sentences to make our own book about big cats. We will even be going on a lion hunt!



In Knowledge & Understanding of the World, we will be learning about habitats and how Africa is similar or different to where we live. We will investigate the animals that live in Africa and compare them to animals that live near and around us. I wonder what African animals eat?

In PSHE we will be learning about personal safety, thinking about how to be safer in a variety of ways. We will identify people who we trust and places in and out of school where we feel safe. We will also explore what it means to have a sixth sense and how to use this to keep safe. We will learn the names for body parts and how to distinguish between 'yes' and 'no' touches. We will explore 'good' and 'bad' secrets and tricks and will also practise assessing risk and developing strategies for keeping safer.

In Communication and Language, we have got a talk box and will be talking about what is inside. We will also be using props and objects to talk about who they may belong to. Our nature table will have exciting things to look at and talk about too.
