

The History of Chocolate

1500 - 400 BC

First recorded use of cacao beans by the Olmec Indians in Mexico.

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900 - 250 BC

The ancient Maya of Mexico and Central America made cacao into a spicy drink mixed with chilli.





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1200 - 1500

The Aztecs used cacao for trade and cacao seeds as a form of money.



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1540

The Spanish brought cacao home and started flavouring it with cinnamon and sugar.

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1657

The first chocolate house was opened in London. Cacao was very expensive and in France, chocolate could be drunk only by the royal family!



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1830

J.S. Fry and Sons of England produce the first moulded bar of 'Eating Chocolate'.
